

Development Update



Lyons Dock Launch

The team are excited to announce Lyons Dock is nearing completion with the first units due to be occupied from May 2022. Over the next three months, the remaining scaffolding surrounding the building will be removed, opening up the development.

Separate landscaping works surrounding the building are currently under construction and will progressively complete across the middle of this year, starting on the northside. Once completed, these works will provide direct access between Greenford Quay

and Oldfield Lane North. This will allow residents to freely travel through the development and straight onto the canalside pathway leading up and down the Grand Union Canal.

To ensure safe passage for the community, the footpath adjacent to the Lyons Dock will remain closed with a temporary pedestrian crossing at Oldfield Lane North road bridge over the canal.

This footpath will be upgraded in the coming months once the building nears completion.
